# YEARLY LIMITS

The School District of Osceola County allows up to **five** excused absences per semester. There is no limit on absences related to medical appointments, court, funerals. Please discuss any other absences that might require many days of nonattendance, with your child's counselor.

## EXCUSED ABSENCES

These types of absences include, but are not limited to:

- Family emergencies
- Personal sickness
- Family trips

## MEDICALLY EXCUSED ABSENCES

These types of absences include, but are not limited to:

- Doctor appointments
- Hospital visits
- Therapy sessions
- Dental appointments
- Vision appointments
- Dermatological appointments

## ASK IF YOU ARE UNSURE!

Different types of absences might require different types of evidence in order to be excused. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you are not sure what to provide!

# WAS YOUR CHILD ABSENT?

## WE ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING FORMS OF EXCUSES:

- Medical excuses
- Funeral announcements
- Court appearances
- Handwritten notes (with attached evidence as necessary)

Excuses may be faxed or scanned/photographed and attached to an email to the attendance office.

Students may also turn in excuses at the attendance office or the front office.
